



Magnet FAQ Sheet

What are the admission requirements?

Currently, there are no qualification requirements for our programs; however, we ask parents and students to carefully consider the extra commitment and responsibility that comes with being a magnet student. In order to remain in our magnet program after enrollment, students MUST maintain:

- A 2.0 GPA ("C" average)
- A "C" or better in their major
- Good attendance
- A good behavioral record

How are students selected?

Students are placed in a pool of applicants and selected by a computerized lottery system. A student's first choice is given preference. A percentage of seats are also reserved for siblings, magnet feeder schools, and students who live in a specific geographical area. In these cases, preference is ONLY given IF KO Knudson is your first choice.

Can my child be in more than one program?

No, students may not be in more than one program; however, magnet students have a second elective in their schedule to explore their interests.

What happens if my student is zoned for KO Knudson?

Being zoned for KO does not automatically qualify a student for our magnet programs; however, s/he may be given geographic preference depending on her/his address.

Where are you located?

We are located on the corner of Sahara and Atlantic Street, just east of Eastern Avenue.

What time does school start?

Magnet students start school at 7:00am and end school at 2:05pm. Parents and students should be advised there may be many after school requirements for magnet students. There is a late bus available at 3:45pm for magnet students who stay after school.

Is transportation provided?

CCSD provides transportation for those students who live north of Desert Inn Road; however, students who live south of Desert Inn Road may still apply. Parents, however, would then be responsible for transportation. NOTE: Please visit <https://magnet.ccsd.net/transportation> for more information about schools within your transportation zone. Parents should be aware that the nearest bus stop/hub may be some distance from their homes.

Are students receiving special education students eligible to attend KO Knudson?

Yes. It is the policy of CCSD to afford equal opportunity in education to all students; however, students must be able to participate fully in the program to which they are accepted.

Are you a uniform school?

Yes. Our students follow standard student attire.

If my student changes his/her mind and wants to return to their zoned school, can they?

No. It is important students understand they are to remain in their program and at KO for ONE YEAR. A contract is initiated upon enrollment and renewed yearly in the spring. Students do not have to reapply once enrolled.
